



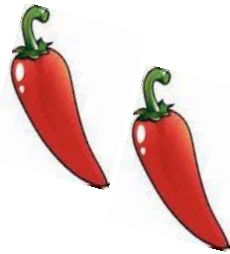

<p>Create a project presenting research on Iceland. <u>Things to think about:</u> Where is Iceland? Why would you want to go there? Are there any famous Icelandic people and events? What language do they speak? Are there any particular traditions and cultural facts? Physical features of Iceland Historical facts</p>	<p>Create a documentary or news report about the conflict between Vikings and Saxons.</p>	<p>Create a documentary about the Anglo Saxons. <u>Top tip</u> You could create a script based on research and record an interview with an Anglo Saxon (obviously not a real one!)</p>
<p>Create your own Bayeux Tapestry on anything you want. Remember it must be a narrative sequence of events in art form.</p>	<p>Create a Powerpoint Presentation about the life of King Alfred</p>	<p>Create a newsreport about the volcanic activity that affected Iceland in 2010</p>
<p>Create a song or poem that can help memorise counting in 25s.</p>	<p>Create a comic book version of the story of Beowulf</p>	<p>Create a model of an Anglo Saxon soldier. Focus on labelling the uniform/armour and its uses.</p>
